

## 2024-2025 USG STEM Mini-Grant Application

The goal of the STEM Mini-Grant is to support undergraduate research by eliminating financial barriers to authentic research projects at the College of Coastal Georgia through providing funds (up to \$1000) to purchase materials necessary for student research. These funds will be awarded to applicants who demonstrate need for necessary reagents/consumables in the lab, field gear for ecological and environmental research, access to crowdsourced survey participants required for psychology research, or other materials and technology. These mini-grants are administered by the ENDEAVOR Center for High Impact Practices and award decisions are made by the Undergraduate Research Advisory Committee based on availability of resources. This mini-grant will not fund travel—do not discuss travel expenses in this application. The board will consider the following criteria for judging:

- Overall quality of application (incomplete applications will not be accepted)
- Research project poses an important question
- Research demonstrates strong theoretical rationale
- Submission has a well-written abstract or description of the project
- A demonstrated need for specific materials to support a specific research project
